Main Discussion Points:			
<p><u>MJTD</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• MJTD explained the purpose of the monthly meeting with local community that it is to communicate with local people for the development of Thilawa SEZ and surrounding area and to hear the necessity of the local community.</li> <li>• 21 numbers of factories are under operation and half of them are in the initial operation stage. 30 numbers of factories are under construction and it takes one year to finish the construction. Next year, there will be 60 numbers of factories which are under operation.</li> </ul> <p><u>Local Community</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Regarding job opportunities, there are a lot of local people who want to work in Thilawa SEZ. When submitting CV, original document of Village Tract (VT) or Ward administrator’s recommendation and police’s recommendation are necessary according to the employers in Thilawa SEZ. Applicants have to get those recommendation letters every time when they apply job in Thilawa SEZ. But they could not get job after submitting their CV several times. Therefore local people become disappointed to apply job in Thilawa SEZ.</li> <li>• In response to the above issue about the recommendation letter, MJTD explained that copy of recommendation letters can be used when applying job in Thilawa SEZ. Applicants are</li> </ul>			

not necessary to get recommendation letters every time when they apply job in Thilawa SEZ.

- Sometimes, local people don't know where to submit CV when they want to apply jobs in Thilawa SEZ.
- In response to the above issue about the submission of CV, MJTD will set up a new system by discussing with TSEZMC and by employing some local people to communicate between local community and Thilawa SEZ regarding job opportunities.
- Classrooms in Myaing Thar Yar High School (Sub) near relocation site in Myaing Thar Yar Village in Nyaung Waing Village Tract is not enough due to the increased number of students from relocation places. Construction of a new building in this school is requested. In addition, upgrading of main roads in Myaing Thar Yar Village in Nyaung Waing Village Tract is requested. An installation of an incinerator is requested near Myaing Thar Yar Village for relocated people.
- Water pipeline construction from the pond in Pha Lan (old Aye Mya Thi Dar ward) to Aye Mya Thi Dar ward for drinking water is requested.
- Renovation of a library in Aye Mya Thi Dar ward is requested as there are precious books in the existing library which is too old to use.
- Street Lights along roads near Thilawa SEZ is requested for safety at night.
- Electricity Supply to Shan Su Village in Nyaung Waing Village Tract is requested.
- In response to the above request about infrastructure, MJTD cannot fulfill all immediately. But MJTD will try its best.
